



Proposed amendments to the Bylaws of the Libertarian Party of Arkansas

The following amendments to the Bylaws of the Libertarian Party of Arkansas have been proposed by the Bylaws Committee and are reported by the Executive Committee to the membership for consideration at the Party's 2025 convention.

IV. State Convention

6. Election of Delegates to National Convention

c. Procedures for selection of Delegates

Delegates will be selected by the Members at the State Convention via approval voting, with each member being allowed to vote for as many eligible candidates as they choose to approve. Only those members that have met all criteria may be considered as delegates. Delegates will be ranked in the order of votes received, and the top vote getters up to the total number of delegates assigned by the National Executive Committee shall be declared as the Delegates to the National Convention. Any candidates that failed to get enough votes to become delegates shall be listed as alternates, ranked in order of number of votes received. Additional alternate delegates will be selected by the Members at the state convention in a separate ballot by the same method. Alternates so chosen will be added to the list in the order of votes received. Alternates are not required to meet the 30 day notification of section IV.6.b, and there is no limit to the number of alternates that may be selected.

d. Finality of delegate selection

~~Neither the delegation nor the delegate chair shall have the authority to add or remove delegates or alternates; except, that the~~ *The* delegation, by majority vote of the delegates attending a delegation meeting, ~~at which a majority of the delegates in attendance at the convention are present, called by the delegate chair during the convention, and after all Arkansas' alternate delegates attending the convention have filled vacant Arkansas delegate seats,~~ may add alternate delegates ~~duly elected by other states to fill vacancies in the Arkansas delegation during the period such a vacancy exists, if not prohibited by the national convention rules.~~ *using criteria agreed to by the majority of delegates attending the delegation meeting. Alternate delegates so added will follow alternates selected at the state convention in order of succession to replace delegates as needed.*
